MATCH OFFICIALS CODE OF CONDUCT

Match Officials agree to:

- Be honest and completely impartial at all times.
- Apply the Laws of the Game and competition rules fairly and consistently.
- Manage the game in a positive, calm and confident manner.
- Deal with all instances of violence, aggression, unsporting behaviour, foul play and other misconduct promptly and fairly.
- Support other match officials at all times.
- Set a positive example by promoting good behaviour from players and officials.
- Set a positive example by showing respect to everyone involved in the game.
- Communicate with players and encourage fair play.
- Respond in a clear, calm and confident manner to any appropriate requests.
- Prepare physically and mentally prior to each match.
- Complete and submit accurate and concise reports within any time limits as required.

Match Officials agree not to:

- Tolerate offensive, insulting or abusive language or behaviour from players or officials.
- Exhibit bad, violent or threatening behaviour.
- Use any foul, abusive or hateful language.
- Bully, harass or belittle any other player, parent, manager, coach or match official.

Any match official found guilty of misconduct may be reported to The FA or the Sussex County FA's refereeing committee.
