PARENT/CARER CODE OF CONDUCT

Parents/Carers agree to:

- Follow the Spectator Code of Conduct in addition to this Code of Conduct.
- Make every effort to support their child in the development of their sporting ability.
- Ensure that all training sessions and matches are attended where possible.
- Give positive support to their child's team at matches.
- Ensure their child has appropriate clothing for match and training conditions.
- Ensure their child has shin pads and correct boots at matches and training sessions.
- Help their child to keep their match kits clean and in good condition.
- Reinforce the rule of not wearing any match kits outside of club events.
- Report any injuries/conditions that may affect their child's ability to their team manager.
- Respect any decision made by managers, coaches and match officials.
- Allow their child to play competitively but fairly, and in-line with the Laws of the Game.
- Respect all players, match officials, managers, coaches and parents.
- Inform their child's manager/coach of any issues with players, parents or match officials.
- Accept that mistakes happen and that nobody is perfect.
- Set a positive example for their child and other players.
- Always stay behind any respect barriers.

Parents/Carers agree **not** to:

- Exhibit bad behaviour at matches and training sessions.
- Use any foul, abusive or hateful language at any match, training session or club event.
- Bully, harass or belittle any other player, parent, manager, coach or match official.
- Exhibit any violent or threatening behaviour towards anyone during or after matches.

Failure to follow the code may result in the parent/carer being warned, asked to attend a meeting with the club or league, be obliged to undertake an FA education course, asked to leave the venue, being banned from future matches, or be asked to leave the club.

Any parent/carer found guilty of misconduct may be required to appear before a disciplinary committee of the club. This includes when additional penalties are incurred, such as being sent off or cautioned. Parents/guardians are responsible for reimbursing the club for any fines that are issued against them or family/friends by the league or a referee.
