PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT

Players agree to:

- Always play to the best of their ability and for the benefit of their team.
- Attend all training sessions and matches where possible.
- Always support and respect their teammates.
- Wear appropriate clothing and equipment for match and training.
- Keep their match kits clean and in good condition.
- Not wear any match kits outside of club events.
- Report any injuries that may affect their ability to their team manager.
- Play competitively but fairly, and always in-line with the Laws of the Game.
- Respect all match officials, managers, coaches and parents.
- Respect their opposition players whether you win, lose or draw.
- Shake hands with their opponents and match officials before and after the game.
- Inform their manager or coach of any issues with players, parents or match officials.
- Accept that mistakes happen and that nobody is perfect.

Players agree not to:

- Exhibit bad behaviour at matches and training sessions.
- Engage in timewasting or un-sportsmanlike behaviour at matches and training sessions.
- Use any foul, abusive or hateful language at any match, training session or club event.
- Not to wear any jewellery at matches or training sessions.
- Not to chew gum at matches or training sessions.
- Bully, harass or belittle any other player, or take part in any such behaviour.

Failure to follow the code may result in the player being asked to apologise, receiving a warning, being dropped or substituted, being suspended from training, or being asked to leave the club.

Any player found guilty of misconduct may be required to appear before a disciplinary committee of the club. This includes when additional penalties are incurred, such as being sent off or cautioned. Parents/guardians of the player are responsible for reimbursing the club for any fines that are issued against their child by the league or a referee.
