SPECTATOR CODE OF CONDUCT

Spectators agree to:

- Give positive support and encouragement at matches.
- Respect any decision made by managers, coaches and match officials.
- Allow players to play competitively but fairly, and in-line with the Laws of the Game.
- Respect all players, match officials, managers, coaches and parents.
- Accept that mistakes happen and that nobody is perfect.
- Set a positive example for their team.
- Always remain behind the respect barrier.
- Let managers and coaches do their job and not tell players what to do.
- Appreciate good play from both teams.

Spectators agree not to:

- Exhibit bad, violent or threatening behaviour at matches or training sessions.
- Use any foul, abusive or hateful language at any match, training session or club event.
- Bully, harass or belittle any other player, parent, manager, coach or match official.

Failure to follow the code may result in the spectator being warned, asked to attend a meeting with the club or league, be obliged to undertake an FA education course, asked to leave the venue, being banned from future matches, or be asked to leave the club.

Any spectator found guilty of serious misconduct may be required to appear before a disciplinary committee of the club. This includes when additional penalties are incurred, such as being sent off or cautioned. Spectators are responsible for reimbursing the club for any fines that are issued against them by the league or a referee.
